Invitation to the women

We cordially invite all women in their menstruation
- we call this time the moon time to use the places for the Moon Time Women and to
celebrate this special time in the circle of sisterhood.

You are invited to experience the great power of the Kiva Ceremony with your higher awareness in a deep way within. Let us open the sacred mysteries of the womb again.

And dear sisters, be prepared and do not be surprised if you menstruate outside of your rhythm as this powerful force from Mother Earth rises into your womb in this strong prayer. When this happens, be aware that the great Goddess and the great Spirit have destined you to take on a special task in the ceremony, for the Earth and for the people.



Four places are available for the Moon Time Women:

The Moonwomen's Place at the Kiva

This place is located to the left of the Kiva entrance.

The moon time women have the wonderful mission during the Kiva Ceremony in their common prayer to build a deep connetion to Mother Earth, to give her gratitude and to support the ceremony with highest feminine love and presence.

The Women's Tent

Up at the forest edge of the campground there is a women's tent, where women can retreat and rest and where women's circles can also take place. There is also the possibility to make salt or herbal bags that will give you protection and keep the moon energy centred on you.

The material is available in the women's tent.

The Moon Offering Place

Every year we open a moon offering place in the forest above the campground where women can give their precious gift to Mother Earth. This place is opened in the women's circle, decorated with much love and blessed with songs and prayers.

There will be a women's workshop on Thursday after lunch at the women's tent at the edge of the forest



The Women's Sweatlodge

When you go to the sweatlodge, please ask for the women's sweatlodge. It is there for the Moon Time Women, but of course also for all other women outside the moon time.

Three more hints

Dear women, during moon time you are released from kitchen duty, from serving food and from working with the fire, in order to be able to go completely into your inner work of the moon time.

Please notice that the Moon Time Women do not enter the kiva at the beginning of the ceremony. If they wish to place items on the altar, they can give them to their family/friends or they will be collected by the Moon Place Keepers and brought to the altar. After the completion of the last kiva ceremony, the Moon Time Women are also allowed to enter the kiva and collect their items from the altar.

And many elders remind us to cover our bodies in prayer and let the spiritual glow become visible. They are happy to see us in long skirts and covered shoulders.
